

Required Tools


•1 Pliers

•1 Rubber Mallet

•1 Flat Head Screwdriver



Sidewall Repair




1. Slide the hinge rod out using pliers.



3. Remove hinge rod and sidewall to replace with new ones.



2. Once the rod is out a few inches, the operator should be able to pull the rod out the rest of the way.



4. Use pliers to install new hinge rod. Erect doors to check for proper fit.

Hinge Repair



1. Take the screwdriver and pry the bottom section of the hinge from its location. Place the screwdriver on the center section of the hinge and push upwards.



2. Use a flat-head screwdriver to separate hinge pins in the center section of the hinge. Use the pliers to pull the hinge pin away from the center section. Stop when the end of the hinge pin is in line with the outer section of the hinge.



3. Remove the hinge and slide the new hinge into the hinge location. Use a screwdriver or fingers to push the two hinge pins towards the center of the hinge.



4. Press down and the new hinge will snap into place. Open and close door to insure correct fit.

Latch Repair



1. Insert the flat-head screwdriver in between the latch and the tab that is holding the latch in place.



2. Push the latch over so it disengages from the tab and the latch will be able to be removed. Remove the latch.



3. Put the new latch in place. Push down on the latch and it will snap into place. Latch replacement is the same for the sidewall and the access door.
